<u>UK Crops:</u> Problems lifting crops due to boggy ground. Ground lying and open produce may have higher levels of field debris & soiling than normal so will require more thorough washing. Salads struggling with size and quality at end of season. <u>Europe/North Africa:</u> Holland finishing. New season Moroccan tomatoes coming through with good volume but some softness. New Spanish peppers are also quite tender which is causing issues with shelf-life.

<u>Seasonal:</u> Toffee apples 75274, mixed edible squashes 96983, display gourds 96069, pumpkins 75026/75097 and Muscat pumpkins now all available. We are also stocking loose sprouts 76938 & 76936 as well. For best colour/ appearance, limited South African (end of season) large easy peel citrus are still available under code 77882
