Shipping: Although no missed deliveries, we are monitoring the situation closely in Europe as suppliers are reporting late deliveries and difficulties with transit through Spain (road closures/repairs) and France (farmers strikes). We have also received reports of some delays expediting deliveries at port in Morocco.

Spain: The weather continues to be wet and humid. There is an increased risk of soiling and field debris in open crops from heavy rain. Although quality appears stable at present and action is being taken to mitigate the impacts; there are concerns that if conditions persist, we will start to see an increase in viruses, moulds and insects which will impact the quality and shelf-life or crops such as lettuces, tomatoes, cucumbers, peppers, aubergines, broccoli & courgettes later in the season. Seasonal: Chestnuts are available in their shells: 76912 or peeled: 05999. We also have red currants 75176 (pre-order) &

cranberries 74948. Loose Brussels sprouts: 76938 or 76936 are also in stock with peeled to follow in December.
