Shipping: Last week's closure at Heathrow airport continues to disrupt airfreight into the UK as up to 90% of cargo via the airport relies on passenger plane hold space with volumes severely limited due to passenger luggage taking precedence. This has impacted short life products such as exotics & soft fruit. We are also seeing long delays out of Morocco due to shorter working hours during Ramadan. Contingencies are in place however, so our supply should remain uninterrupted.

Spain: Rain and flooding continued in Spain again last week with some fields endured up to 14 days of precipitation leading to difficulty harvesting. Heads are moisture heavy so susceptible to bruising and discolouration. Outer leaves will be discoloured due oxidisation and require removal before use. Lettuce is the most affected with growers warning of potential quality issues like spear rot and moulds developing later in crops like broccoli due to standing water in heads.

Seasonal: LIK cauliflowers are now back in stock, curds will be towards the lower end of the size specification until the crop.
